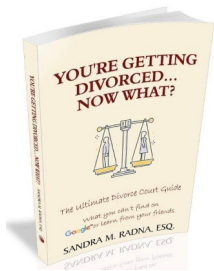

8	Will you have the opportunity to review letter or court documents before they are sent to your spouse's attorney or filed with the court?	



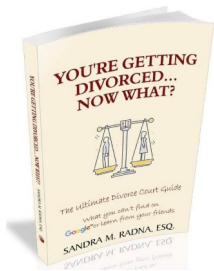

2	Were they professional?	
3	Did the office seem organized?	
4	Did the attorney rush you, while you were explaining your situation?	
5	Did the attorney interrupt you repeatedly when you were explaining your situation?	
6	Did the attorney appear to be knowledgeable about the issues that you discussed?	
7	Did the attorney appear to be considerate?	
8	Did the attorney have a plan for you by the end of the meeting?
